3. The applicant will be contacted for an interview by the Selection Committee.
4. Those applicants selected will be notified of acceptance.

CRITERIA

- Leadership East County 2nd Year Master's program is an issue-oriented leadership development program designed to inform, motivate and increase the awareness of selected participants through seminars, study groups and interactions with community decision-makers and regional leaders and motivators.
- Program Philosophy/Mission
 - Program is for Purpose Driven People Who Want to Make a Difference in their community through a second year, transformational leadership learning program.
 - Program stresses complex issue problem-solving and individual leadership development.

Leadership East county seeks up to twenty (20) individuals who:

1. Are purpose-driven people who want to make a difference in their community.
2. Are executives, community and business leaders.
3. Graduates of Leadership East County Program or Equivalent.
4. Possess high standards of high standards of personal quality and integrity.
5. Have a record of achievement in community activities that indicates past and potential leadership and abilities.
6. Agree to commit the necessary time and effort to complete the program, one day each month beginning in September for a total of ten days (cannot miss more than one month).
